

Cultural and Heritage Venue Operations

Advanced Apprenticeship Level 3

Overview:

This qualification is for those who provide support in the culture and heritage sector, for example warders, attendants, volunteers and part-time staff. It gives learners the opportunity to have skills recognised and gives a thorough grounding in heritage and the creative and cultural sector. Learners are able to choose from a range of units that reflect their work.

Qualification: Level 3 Cultural and Heritage Venue Operation (QCF)

Duration: 10-12 months **Dates:** Start at any time of the year

Delivery: Primarily at the Apprentice's place of work with some attendance at college

Mandatory units:

- Maintain competence and undertake work-related learning in the creative and cultural sector
- Taking responsibility for work in a creative and cultural context
- Work effectively with other people in a creative and cultural context
- Ensure responsibility for actions to reduce risks to health and safety

Choose from optional units including:

- Design exhibitions/displays for cultural heritage
- Develop, lead and motivate others in a creative and cultural organisation
- Manage budgets in a creative and cultural context
- Plan and deliver learning or interpretation activities in a creative and cultural context
- Inspect and monitor cultural heritage for conservation purposes
- Promote and sell goods and services in a creative and cultural organisation
- Raise funds for a creative and cultural organisation
- Apply preventative conservation measures for cultural heritage
